At the age of 18, the musician embarked on a tour with blues guitarist Jimmie Vaughan’s band *The Fabulous Thunderbirds*. Since then, Bramhall II has become a household name, writing and performing a slew of classic hits. Fans can expect a night of musical bliss as Bramhall II delivers an exceptional live performance on the Showroom stage.

Two years after his tour with *The Fabulous Thunderbirds* ended, Bramhall II co-founded rock band *Arc Angels*. He released his self-titled debut album in 1996 and followed up with his second studio album titled “Jellycream” in 1999. Both records received tremendous praise and eventually gained the attention of blues greats Eric Clapton and Roger Waters. Bramhall II would go on to collaborate with both musicians – playing the guitar on Waters’ “In the Flesh Tour” and Clapton’s *Riding With The King* album – as well as Sheryl Crow, Elton John, Gregg Allman and Dr. John. Today, he continues to tour across the country while developing his anticipated fourth studio album.
